What is Deaf-Blindness?

Kids with a diagnosis of **deaf-blindness** have both **severe hearing** and **vision loss**. Their communication and other needs are so unique that programs for just the deaf or blind **cannot** meet them.





Federal Definition of Deaf-Blindness

Deaf-blindness means **concomitant hearing** and **visual impairments**, the combination of which causes such **severe communication** and other **developmental** and **educational** needs that they **cannot** be accommodated in special education programs solely for children with deafness or children with blindness.
