Emotional Disturbance

What is Emotional Disturbance ?

Various mental health issues can fall under the **"emotional** disturbance" category. They may include anxiety disorder, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, and depression. (May also be covered under OHI)

What Does NOT Apply As Emotional Disturbance ?

The term does **not** apply to children who are **socially maladjusted**, unless it is determined that they have an emotional disturbance.



Federal Definition of Emotional Disturbance

Emotional disturbance means a condition exhibiting one or more of the following characteristics over a long period of time and to a marked degree that adversely affects a child's educational performance:



- Inability to learn that cannot be explained by intellectual, sensory, or health factors.
- Inability to **build** or **maintain** satisfactory interpersonal relationships with **peers** and **teachers**.
- Inappropriate types of **behavior** or **feelings** under normal circumstances.
- General pervasive mood of **unhappiness** or **depression**.
- Tendency to develop physical symptoms or fears associated with personal or school problems.
