

Other Health Impairments (OHI)

What is Other Health Impairments (OHI) ?

The **"other health impairment"** category covers conditions that limit a child's **strength, energy,** or **alertness**.

Federal Definition of OHI

Other health impairment means having limited strength, vitality, or alertness, including a heightened alertness to environmental stimuli, that results in limited alertness with respect to the educational environment.

Causes of OHI

- Chronic or acute health problems such as: Asthma,
 (ADD), (ADHD), Diabetes, Epilepsy, a heart condition,
 Hemophilia, Lead Poisoning, Leukemia, Nephritis,
 Rheumatic Fever, Sickle Cell Anemia, and Tourette
 Syndrome.
- **OHI** adversely affects a child's educational performance.
